

Das **Simple Future** auch das **Will-Future** genannt ist eine Zukunftsform, die du verwendest über die Zukunft zu sprechen.

I **will call** you.

Will you **help** me?

We **won't come** (**will not come**) to the party.

BILDUNG

(+) Subjekt + **WILL** + Verb

(?) **WILL** + Subjekt + Verb ?

(-) Subjekt + **WILL** + **NOT** + Verb

(-) Subjekt + **WON'T** + Verb

POSITIVE AUSSAGEN - I will call you tonight.

I **will call** - I'll **call**

you **will call** - you'll **call**

he **will call** - he'll **call**

she **will call** - she'll **call**

it **will call** - it'll **call**

we **will call** - we'll **call**

I **will be** - I'll **be**

Das **Will-Future** wird verwendet um über Folgendes zu sprechen,

Vermutungen – I think – ich denke

I think she **will pass** her English test.

Erwartungen – I expect – ich erwarte

I expect she **will pass** her English test.

Hoffnungen – I hope – ich hoffe

I hope she **will pass** her English test.

Befürchtungen – I fear – ich befürchte

I fear she **will not pass** her English test.

Vorhersagen – It is possible that – Es ist möglich, dass

It is possible that in 100 years people **will live** on Mars.

Spontane Entscheidungen (im Restaurant)

I **will have** a cup of coffee.

Formelle Termine / Treffen

The meeting **will take place** on Monday.

Formelle Ankündigungen

The King **will greet** the crowd.

Bitten (meist mit please)

Will you **call** me tonight, please?

VERWENDUNG (USE)

Das **Will-Future** wird verwendet mit den folgenden Signalwörtern,

PROBABLY, MAYBE, PERHAPS, POSSIBLY - vielleicht

IT IS POSSIBLE - Es ist möglich

WHEN I'M (18 years old) - Wenn ich (18) bin

WHEN I'M OLDER - Wenn ich älter bin

think - denken

worry - sich Sorgen machen

fear, be afraid - befürchten

bet - wetten

doubt - bezweifeln

worry - besorgt sein

promise - versprechen

hope - hoffen

wonder - wissen wollen

Das **Will-Future** wird verwendet mit den folgenden Zeitangaben,

tomorrow - morgen

next week, next year - nächste Woche, nächstes Jahr

this year - dieses Jahr

in the future, in the near Future - in der Zukunft, in naher Zukunft

in 2050 - im Jahr 2050

in two days - in zwei Tagen

in ten years' time - in zehn Jahren

sooner or later - früher oder später

soon - bald

WILL-FUTURE

VERWENDUNG (USE)

FIRST CONDITIONAL

Das **Will-Future** wird auch verwendet, um First Conditional Sätze - Bedingungssätze Typ 1 - zu bilden.

Der Hauptsatz steht im **Will-Future**, der Nebensatz im Simple Present.

She **will pass** her English test IF she works hard.

She **won't pass** her English test IF she doesn't work hard.

She **won't pass** her English test UNLESS she works hard.
(unless - if not)

ZEIT-NEBENSÄTZE

Der Hauptsatz steht im **Will-Future**, der Nebensatz im Simple Present. Es gibt andere Signalwörter für Nebensätze,

WHEN, AS SOON AS; BEFORE, AFTER

I **will call** you AS SOON AS I get home.

AS SOON AS I get home, I **will call** you.

WHEN I get home, I **will call** you.

BEFORE I call you, I **will have** a cup of tea.

FRAGEN - Will you call me tonight?

Will I call?
 Will you call?
 Will he call?
 Will she call?
 Will it call?
 Will we call?
 Will you call?
 Will they call?

Yes, I **will**.
 Yes, you **will**.
 Yes, he **will**.
